Manchester Growing Together Garden/Farm

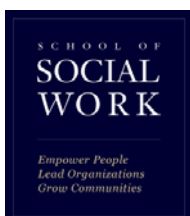
Manchester Growing Together Garden/Farm is pleased to host the first **“Unity in the Community: We Are Not Alone”**
